

## ASAP 2010 Young Members Travel Award

The members travel award is to be used to encourage a member to travel to international conferences and places of work to benefit their career and the animal industries of Australia. It is restricted to young members, current postgraduate students or a postgraduate of any age within 5 years of the award of the postgraduate qualification.

### Conditions

- Members under the age of 35 years at the 30 June in year of application or a current postgraduate student member or a member of any age who has been a recent postgraduate student and graduated with a recognised postgraduate qualification within 5 years of the 31 December in year of application are eligible.
- Up to two (2) awards will be made the year of the biennial conference.
- A sum of up to \$4000 is available for the successful person.
- The award is to be used to attend a conference, laboratories or animal enterprises overseas or in exceptional circumstances an Australian international conference. For the latter, a sum of up to \$2000 would be awarded.
- Applications will be called in April for awards to be announced at the biennial conference. Federal Council may vary the date for applications to better align with known international conferences.
- The application form is to be submitted along with any supporting evidence to the Federal Secretary of the Australian Society of Animal Production by 28 June 2010.
- A one page report suitable for inclusion in the Federal Newsletter and publication on the ASAP website must be submitted within 3 months of completion of the activity.
